Exhibitors must set up during allotted times and must keep their booths in place until 4:00 pm July 20. Vendors not staying for Thursday night events may quietly begin taking down during the final discussion session, 4:00-4:45.

Our conference is structured to allow non-registering exhibitors to participate in sessions at their discretion, while receiving maximum benefit of exhibit and networking time. We schedule door-prize drawings throughout the conference and would be happy to include items you would like to donate, for added exposure.
